BASIS Swimming Pool & Event Information

Warm-Up:

- Open warm-up begins at 7:00 A.M.
- Lanes will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. Please use common courtesy and share lanes with other teams as needed. Swimmers stay on the right side.

Pool Facilities:

- Covered 25-meter heated pool with 8 lanes.
- Electronic timing system for competition use.
- Poolside spectator area.

Pool Specs:

- Length: 25 meters.
- Lanes: 8
- Depth: 1.35 - 2.0 meters. (shallow to deep end)

Safety:

- 2 Lifeguards will be on duty during the event.

Spectators:

- Parents and spectators are welcome.
- All spectators and parents must sign in at the registration desk and wear their school lanyard or exchange a visitor lanyard to enter the campus upon their arrival. The lanyard must be worn all the time on the school premises.

Food:

- Food will be available to purchase at the campus for your convenience.

BASIS Swim Meet Information & Scoring Criteria

Competition Format:

- **Timed Finals:** All events will be scored based on the fastest recorded times.
- **Age Groups:** Swimmers will compete in their appropriate age group (U6-U16). The swimmers age will be calculated as of November 15th 2025.
- **Age Up Option:** Swimmers can compete in an older age group if desired.
- **Events per Swimmer:** All swimmers can participate in up to 6 events. U6-10 swimmers can participate in all 25m events, 100m IM, one relay. 11-U16 swimmers can participate in all 50m events, 100m IM, one relay.
- **One Start Rule:** U6-10 start shallow end. 11-U16 Swimmers can choose poolside or block start.
- **Heat Seeding:** Heats will be organized from slowest swimmers to fastest.

Rules / regulations:

- World Aquatics rules will apply; however, we will ask referees to be lenient with the younger age groups, including a one-start rule. A false start will result in a DQ, and the race will continue.
- Protests can be submitted by a team coach. No parent should communicate with the officials or host staff.
- There will be a 30-minute time limit on protests, as per World Aquatics rules.
- Electronic timing will be used.
- TSA referees
- Mobile application to check results (Meet Mobile)
- * We have dive blocks at one side of the pool, and our pool meets FINA standards, however, the shallow end is 1.35m so please advise your weaker swimmers to start either poolside or in the water if they are not confident starters during events.

Scoring:

- Individual Events: Points will be awarded to the top 8 finishers in each event (20 points for 1st, 18 points for 2nd, and so on down to 6 points for 8th place).
- Relay Events: Points will be awarded to the top 8 finishing teams (40 points for 1st, 36 points for 2nd, and so on down to 12 points for 8th place).

Awards:

- **All Swimmers:** Every participant will receive a gift.
- **Individual Events:**
 - Medals will be awarded to the top 3 finishers (1st, 2nd, and 3rd) in each individual event.
 - Ribbon will be awarded to the fastest heat swimmer.
- **Relay Events:** Medals will be awarded to the top 3 finishing teams (1st, 2nd, and 3rd) in each relay event.
- **Team Trophies:** Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 teams based on total points earned.

Entry Fees & Payment:

- **Entry Fee:** The entry fee is 800 THB per swimmer. This includes, TSA Officials, Referees, timers, data recording and goody bag.
- **Registration Deadline:** Registration closes on **Friday, October 17th 2025 prior to 4:00 P.M.**
- **Invoice:** Invoices will be issued between **Monday, 19th to Friday, 24th October 2025.**
- **Payment Deadline:** Payment is due by **Friday 31st October 2025 at 4:00 P.M.** The pay slip should be emailed to Khun Apple t.asawasuntikul@basis.ac.th
- **Non-Refundable:** Entry fees are non-refundable.

Spectator Seating:

- **Designated Zones:** Specific areas around the pool are designated for parent seating.
- **Standing Areas:** Due to space limitations, parents/families may stand in certain areas of the pool deck to observe their children.
- **Restricted Areas:** Parents/Families are **not** allowed to enter the swimmer zone and should remain within the designated seating and rest areas. The canteen area offers additional seating near food, beverage, and vendor options.

Swimmer Zone:

- **Rest Areas:** Designated rest areas will be provided in the swimmer zone for each swim team. Coaches and staff from each school must supervise their team.

Warm-Up Zone:

- **Team Warm-Up:** Team will have designated warm-up zone at the 3rd floor gym supervised by their coaches.
- **Pool Warm-Up:** The pool will be opened for warm-up from 7:00 A.M. to 7:45 A.M.

Spectator Information:

- **Support Encouraged:** Parents/Families are encouraged to attend and support their children during the swimming meet.
- **Parent Lanyard:** Please ensure you have your parent's lanyard for security verification.

- **Designated Viewing:** Spectators are kindly requested to observe the competition only from the grandstands by the pool.
- **Restroom Locations:** Adult restrooms are located next to the canteen. Children's restrooms are next to the basketball court and on the ground floor between the pool and field.
